AUSTRALIAN BAR ASSOCIATION (ABA) ADVANCED ADVOCACY COURSE BRISBANE 2010

To be held in conjunction with the Bar Association of Queensland

17-22 January 2010, Brisbane

Registration for the ABA Advanced Advocacy Course will open on **1 July 2009**.

The course will be held from 17-22 January 2010 at the Supreme Court of Queensland and Sebel Citigate King George Square.

Places in the course are limited to people with seniority of at least two years at the private Bar. The Course is designed for experienced advocates who wish to take that next step in their professional development.

There are places available for up to 48 barristers from around Australia. For one month (from 1 July 2009) positions will be reserved to allow barristers from each State and Territory to apply. Thereafter places will be available on a first-come basis until all positions are filled.

The coaching faculty will comprise top senior Australian and international barristers, judges and performance coaches.

The course provides an opportunity for barristers to develop their advocacy skills by preparing a civil case and experimenting with a number of styles of performance to see which is the most effective for that advocate on that occasion.

Rarely do barristers have the opportunity of seeing their own performances played back so that they can be examined by the barrister themselves. And never in professional practice is there an opportunity to have a number of senior practitioners analyse performances and provide intensive and supportive feedback about ways to improve. This course provides each of these elements and much more.

The cost for the course is \$3,000 (GST inclusive). This cost covers all course materials and readings; course venue, equipment, transcript, five nights accommodation (Monday-Friday nights), all meals, including a final course dinner at a different venue.
