In particular, you will display a deep appreciation of the role of the IRC in building a more competitive public sector in NSW. It is also important that you have the capacity to resolve industrial disputes and conciliating and, if necessary, arbitrating disputes in a prompt and fair manner with a minimum of legal technicality.

Individuals must have the capacity to construct creative solutions to complex and/or volatile industrial disputes, and be able to provide timely written reasons for decisions. You will possess a very good understanding of NSW industrial relations legislation or the ability to quickly obtain such an understanding.

Under the NSW Industrial Relations Act, a person is not eligible to be appointed as a non-judicial member of the Commission if they are of or above 65 years of age.
