Professor Marshall is in Sydney in this week to provide advice and high level training to staff of the NSW Department of Corrective Services with respect to the treatment of sex offenders. He is regarded by many as the world's pre-eminent authority on treatment of sexual perpetrators.

Professor Marshall is an Emeritus Professor of Psychology and Psychiatry at Queen's University in Canada and the Director of Rockwood Psychological Services which provides treatment for incarcerated sexual offenders. He has been treating and doing work with sexual offenders for 36 years and has over 300 publications including 16 books. In 1999 he was the recipient of the Santiago Grisolia Prize for his worldwide contributions to the reduction of violence and in 2000 he was elected a Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada. He was the President of the Association for the Treatment of Sexual Abusers from 2000 to 2001.
