

PRACTISING CERTIFICATE RENEWALS 2008-09 RENEWALS UPDATE # 2

2107 barristers were sent practising certificate renewal notices - only just over a quarter of that number have so far been returned for processing.

REMINDER

ALL PRACTISING CERTIFICATE RENEWAL DOCUMENTATION AND PAYMENT MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE ASSOCIATION BY 7 JUNE 2008 OTHERWISE A LATE FEE APPLIES.

As 7 June is a Saturday, please ensure to send in your renewal documentation and payment by this Friday 6 June to allow time for the considerable amount of work that has to be undertaken by Bar Association staff to process more than 2100 renewals.

PLEASE NOTE:

Do not wait until you have bound insurance before sending in your renewal documentation and payment. Insurance details can be matched up with your renewal documentation at a later date. However, your practising certificate will not be issued until notification regarding your insurance has been received.
