***ALL PRACTISING CERTIFICATE RENEWAL***  
***DOCUMENTATION AND PAYMENT MUST BE***  
***RECEIVED BY THE ASSOCIATION BY***  
***THURSDAY 7 JUNE 2007***  
***OTHERWISE A LATE FEE APPLIES.***

***PLEASE NOTE:***

**Do not** wait until you have found insurance before sending in your renewal documentation and payment. Insurance details can be matched up with your renewal documentation at a later date. However, your practising certificate will not be issued until notification regarding your insurance has been received.

2099 barristers were sent renewal notices - only just over a quarter of that number have been returned for processing.

If a renewal application is received after 7 June, **there can be no guarantee that a practising certificate for 2007-2008 will be issued before 1 July 2007.** A considerable amount of work has to be undertaken by Bar Association staff to issue a practising certificate. Renewal applications are processed in order of receipt.
