

Henry Russell Braddon

Henry (Harry) Russell Braddon was the son of prominent politician and businessman Henry Yule Braddon. Henry Russell enlisted 16 January, 1916, and embarked 30 September on *Aeneas* as second-lieutenant with 6th Reinforcements for Australian Field Artillery Howitzer Batteries. Joined 13th Battery Australian Field Artillery after Bullecourt II, 19th May, 1917. Transferring to 14th Battery on 25th October 1917 served with it until demobilisation. Promoted lieutenant, 1st August, 1917. Served as a gas officer. Both his brothers enlisted for service. His father was a leading figure in the New South Wales Red Cross and Comforts Funds.

Admitted to the New South Wales Bar 27 July 1916. Read at Middle Temple 3 January 1919 to 3 May 1919 before returning to Australia.
