

## Lennard Campbell Badham

Lennard Badham was the grandson of Professor Badham of Sydney University. He worked as a journalist before moving into law and was at one time the editor of the *Gundagai Times*. Badham enlisted as a gunner in the 7<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery on 8 May 1916, aged 30. He listed his occupation as a law student. He was admitted to the bar on 31 May 1916, wearing his military uniform along with wig and gown.

Badham embarked on *Aeneas* on 30 September 1916. He was sent to France in early 1917 and served with the Field Artillery. His health deteriorated through illness and injury and he spent much of 1917 in hospital before returning to Australia later in the year.

After the war Badham practised out of Denman Chambers and on the Northern Circuit.

He was appointed as king's counsel on 29 November 1944.
